Guidelines for Oral (Paper) Presenters

1. Presentation Format

- Each oral presentation will be **12 minutes**, followed by **3 minutes for Q&A**.
- Please ensure your talk is well-timed and rehearsed to stay within the allotted 15 minutes.
- Presentations should be delivered in **English**.
- You may use **PowerPoint (.pptx)** or **PDF** slides.
- Bring your presentation on a **USB drive**, and also email a backup copy to iccp2026@montfortcollege.edu.in at least **3 days before your session**.

2. Content and Structure

Your presentation should clearly convey your research within the time limit. Suggested structure:

1. **Title Slide** – include title, authors, institutional affiliation(s).
2. **Introduction** – outline research question or problem.
3. **Literature Review / Theoretical Background** – brief summary of key sources (APA 7th citation style).
4. **Method** – participants, tools/instruments, and procedure.
5. **Results** – key findings with concise visuals (tables, charts, figures).
6. **Discussion / Implications** – interpretation of findings in light of the conference theme.
7. **References** – follow **APA 7th edition** format; keep only the most relevant ones on your final slide.

3. Design Tips

- Use a **minimum 24-point font** for readability.
- Avoid dense text; use keywords and visuals.
- Limit slides to about **10–12** for a 12-minute talk.
- Use high-contrast colours and legible fonts.
- Include your **institutional logo** and the **ICCP 2026 logo** if applicable.

4. Session Details

- Presenters must report to their session chair **10 minutes before the session begins**.
- Ensure compatibility of fonts and media; test slides in advance.
- Certificates of presentation will be issued by email

Guidelines for Poster Presenters

1. Poster Specifications

- Poster size: **A0 (84.1 cm × 118.9 cm), portrait orientation.**
- Title should be in **bold, at least 70 points**, with author names and affiliations below.
- Use **APA 7th edition** citation style for all references and in-text citations.
- Text should be **legible from 1–1.5 meters** away (body text 24–36 points).

2. Poster Content Structure

1. **Title & Author Information**
2. **Abstract / Introduction**
3. **Research Question / Objectives**
4. **Method**
5. **Results / Data Visualizations**
6. **Discussion / Key Implications**
7. **References (APA 7th)**
8. **Acknowledgements & Contact Information**

3. Display & Interaction

- Posters should be displayed on **assigned panels** for the duration of your session.
- You are expected to be present at your poster during the designated **poster session time** to interact with delegates.
- Please bring your poster **printed and ready to mount** (pins or Velcro will be provided).
- Digital copies (PDF) should also be emailed to **[insert email]** before **December [insert date], 2025.**

APA 7th Edition Quick Reference

- **In-text citation:** (Author, Year) or (Author et al., Year).
- **Reference list format:**
 - Journal Article: *Author, A. A., & Author, B. B. (Year). Title of the article. Journal Name, volume(issue), page range. <https://doi.org/...>*
 - Book: *Author, A. A. (Year). Title of the book. Publisher.*
- Use **double spacing** and **hanging indents** in reference lists (for written materials).
